Dear Parents and Carers,

Parking

It has been brought to my attention that some parents, whose children attend Wood End Infant school, are not parking in a considerate manner when dropping off or collecting their children.

A local resident came to the school yesterday and informed us that a parent had parked on her driveway. When she asked him to remove his car, he became abusive towards her. This is not acceptable and I would ask that all parents are respectful towards all members of Team Wood End, which includes our neighbours. The police have been contacted regarding this matter and will be patrolling at the beginning and end of the school day.

I appreciate that parking can be difficult, but the Highway Code must be observed at all times. In particular, please do not park on zigzag lines next to zebra crossings; across, or on driveways that do not belong to you; on yellow lines; or on private property. Failure to observe the law may result in you receiving a fixed penalty notice. Always show consideration to our neighbours when parking.

I am aware that there is limited parking around the school, but, the vast majority of our children live less than 1 mile away. Wherever possible, please walk to school to ease congestion; a walk can also prepare your child for the school day and on the way home allow you time to talk about the day's activities.
