

## Year 2 Home Pack

Dear Parents and Carers,

It is very important that although the school has closed, children are still receiving daily practice at the knowledge and skills they have acquired during this term. This will ensure that when they come back, they are ready to carry on with learning and do not struggle to retrieve information and skills.

Attached is a pack for year 2. We recommend the following:

- A maths sheet per day (these are units we have covered so children should be able to get through them).
- A handwriting sheet per day (check your child's posture and pencil grip)
- Get your children to spell the common exception words, and if they get any wrong, practice those with them daily.
- Children have a suffix worksheet – complete that in week one
- Complete either the maths 2017 paper or the Reading 2017 paper at the end of the week.

*It is expected that the maths test paper takes children about 20 minutes to complete and the reading paper 30 minutes to complete. Once the test paper is complete, go through the answers with your child – how did they get their answer? Discuss efficient ways.*

There is also additional online tasks/activities which we encourage children to complete:

- Children have been given a log in for my maths. Work will be added on Fridays so please log in and allow your child to complete the tasks.
- Bug club has also been updated. Please allow your child to log in and read one book a day.

**Please ensure children read every day whether it is on bug club or using a book. Sign these in the yellow record books.**

**Allow children rest between tasks and give them feedback about what they have done well and what they can improve on – at wood End we encourage reflective and determined learners so we expect them to take on feedback, improve their work and never give up.**

Please stay safe during this time and continue to follow the government's advice.
